Enhancing the Impact of Clinical and Translational Research Through Dissemination and Implementation Science

Submit an abstract to present at this year's <u>CCTSI CU-CSU Summit.</u> Researchers in any area of clinical and translational research are invited to present, especially those with a focus in dissemination & implementation (D&I) science, health services research, and/or public health or policy research.

Three presentation opportunities are available this year:

- Poster Session (any clinical and translational research welcome!)
- These abstracts should follow a standard scientific abstract structure (background, methods, results, discussion) and are limited to 300 words.
- Dissemination, Implementation and Sustainability Research Lightning Presentations (5-minute oral presentations on research in D&I science)
- These abstracts should follow a standard scientific abstract structure (background, methods, results, discussion) and are limited to 300 words.
- Where relevant, please describe use of engagement methods, D&I frameworks (e.g., RE-AIM, EPIS), and/or methods for evaluating D&I outcomes (e.g., fidelity, adaptations, reach, equity).
- TSBM case study presentations: <u>Applying the Translational Sciences Benefits Model (TSBM) Impact</u>
 <u>Profile</u> (15-minute oral presentations)
- We are looking for investigators with case examples of research "products" that align with at least <u>one of four domains of "clinical and translational research benefits"</u> as defined by the TSBM. (*The "products" of research include evidence, interventions, devices, methods, policies, and guidelines.*)
- TSBM domains include <u>clinical and medical benefits</u> (e.g., drugs, diagnostic procedures, biomedical technology), <u>community and public health benefits</u> (e.g., community health services, disease prevention and management, health care delivery), <u>economic benefits</u> (e.g., non-profit or commercial entities, patents, license agreement, cost effectiveness) and <u>policy and legislative benefits</u> (e.g., policies, standards, legislation)
- In lieu of an abstract, submit a 200-word description of your product and indicate the TSBM category, and we will work with you to develop an Impact Profile to present at the Summit. These submissions should include the following sections: summary, significance, and benefits, including potential equity impact of your product.
